Moses Is Born

Hello Parents,

Today was our first lesson from our series, "Moses Is Born". We learned that Israel had favour with Egypt because of Joseph, and a new King came to power who did not know Joseph. The new King said that there were too many Israelites and that it could threaten Egypt if a war broke out. So slave masters were put over the Israelites to oppress them but the Israelites multiplied and grew even more. The midwives feared God more than the King. A Levite man & woman had a baby boy and hid him for three months, and when he was too big she put him in a waterproof basket. She then placed him into the river to hide him. The baby was found and went to live in Pharaoh's court. The King's daughter named him Moses, which means 'I drew him out of the water'.
